Age 85, formerly of Golden Valley, passed away peacefully Tuesday evening, October 24, 2017 in Minneapolis, MN. Born in Boston, Larry learned to love seafood, sailing and family gatherings at the beach. A polio survivor as a young child, he went on to attend the prestigious Boston Latin School where his love of learning was cultivated. Larry graduated from Harvard University and Tufts Medical School, launching his career as a pediatrician. After his wife Reva died, he became an allergist so he could have more regular hours to raise his two young children. He later married Alice Briskin Sholler and for the last 35 years has been the steadfast patriarch of the Sholler/Briskin clan. The seamlessly blended family that resulted was in large part due to Larry's incredible love, generosity and emphasis on family togetherness. He was a thoughtful and generous father figure, a devoted husband to Alice and a beloved grandfather to his 9 grandkids. Survived by his wife, Alice Sholler; his children, Joseph Sholler (Helen), Alison Sholler Mund (John), Raquel Briskin Counihan (Kevin), Lisa Briskin Westreich (Larry), Danny Briskin (Taly); and his grandchildren, Noah, Tali and Ari Westreich, Abby and Ella Counihan, Amanda and Jonah Briskin, and Zachery and Reva Mund; as well as numerous cousins and friends who knew and loved him as a kind and gentle man with a wry sense of humor.
