Born on January 21, 1944, LeAnn was the cherished daughter of Alex and Agnes Lewno. She was a lifelong Minnesotan and a woman of quiet strength, deep faith, and unwavering devotion to her family. For nearly 20 years, she made her home at Autumn Woods Apartments in St. Anthony, where she built lasting friendships and a close-knit community.

During the course of her life, LeAnn worked as an accomplished accountant at Honeywell, the University of Minnesota, Comprehensive Epilepsy, and the Child Neurology Society. She was known for her precision, professionalism, and quiet dedication to her work.

LeAnn will be honored with a funeral Mass at St. John the Baptist Catholic Church in New Brighton, Minnesota. In accordance with her wishes, she will be cremated and laid to rest near her parents at Resurrection Cemetery in Mendota Heights.
