Lee Grube was born in Rhinelander, WI on June 7, 1956, son of Walter John Grube and Shirley Mae Grube (nee Bruns). He passed away on April 11, 2026. Lee was the second of three, his big sister was Linda Ann and his little sister was Lori Jean - Lee was the middle kid. He was nurtured within a good, loving, and christian family.

Lee graduated from Horace Mann High School in 1974. He went on to Fox Valley Technical Institute in Appleton, WI, receiving an Associates Degree in Electronic Technology in 1976. Then in January of 1977 he went on to UW Stout, Menomonie, WI, and earned a Bachelor of Science Degree (with mid honors) in Industrial Technology/Electronics Concentration and math minor in 1979.
