Lee Edward James Seck, the son of Margaret Leona Reich and Edward George Seck, born on December 17th, 1937 in Minneapolis MN. His Childhood years were spent near Mound and Excelsior, MN.

He graduated from Minnetonka High School in 1955. He then enlisted in the U.S. Air Force in 1956, and was honorably discharged as an Airman First Class in 1962.

Lee married Margaret (Peggy) Overeen of rural Dickens, Iowa on April 16th, 1970. They resided in St. Louis Park, MN until 2023.

He was employed by the U.S. postal service as a letter carrier and retired after 34 years of service in 1992.
