Woo, Lena 93, Bloomington, MN, passed away March 1, 2010. She lived a full, happy life and will be missed by her many relatives and friends of all ages living here and abroad. She found the greatest joy in spending time with her family and friends, and was a devoted member of her church where she was an active member for over 20 years. Born in Shanghai, China on January 5, 1917 to Wong Kwai Cheung and Cheng Po Kum, she married Woo Chiu Hung in 1938 in Shanghai. During the Japanese occupation of Shanghai, she moved to Hong Kong where her son, Ed, was born. In 1943, she moved to Chongqing and then to India where her husband, who worked for China National Air Corporation (C.N.A.C) as part of the airlift supplying the Chinese government over the Burmese hump. Her youngest son, Ted, was born in Calcutta. After WWII, she returned to Shanghai where she lived for 11 years. In 1957, Mrs. Woo and her husband, then with Pam Am, relocated the family to Hong Kong where they lived in the Happy Valley neighborhood for the next 21 years. Upon her husband's retirement from Pan Am in 1978, she immigrated to the USA and lived in the Twin Cities, spending a few years in Honolulu, Hawaii, until her passing. Predeceased by her husband in 1986 and her eldest son in 2007, she is survived by her son Ted (Alice) (grandkids Michelle and Philip); daughter-in-law Lillian (grandkids David and Betty) of Taipei, Taiwan.
