Leonard Andrew "Len" Pierce, age 87, passed away on May 10, 2026. Len was born on March 18, 1939, in Hot Springs, South Dakota, to Raymond H. Pierce and Frances E. Roe Pierce. He spent his childhood growing up on a cattle ranch in Cascade, South Dakota, where he developed the strong work ethic and quiet determination that would guide him throughout his life.

Len attended Coffee Flats School through the fifth grade and graduated from Hot Springs High School. He continued his education at the South Dakota School of Mines and Technology and later at the University of South Dakota, where he earned a degree in business.

On September 4, 1960, Len married Brenda Brugmann. Together they welcomed two children: Michael Raymond Pierce, born July 28, 1961, in Hot Springs, South Dakota, and Pamela Sue Pierce Saba, born March 24, 1963, in Syracuse, New York. On August 24, 1973, Len married Sheryl Elliott in Hot Springs, South Dakota. Soon after, he left Control Data Corporation and spent the remainder of his career working as a computer consultant for several companies. He enjoyed a

long and successful career in the technology field before retiring on August 20, 2020. Len and Sheryl made their home in Bloomington, Minnesota, where they shared many happy years together.

Len will be remembered for his dedication to his family, his intelligence and professionalism, and his steady, dependable nature. He especially treasured time spent with his loved ones and held a special place in his heart for his beloved dogs, Benji and Riley.
