“ *The family of Leone is slowly finding out about her death. Leone & my mother were 1st cousins. Their mothers - Vendla & Alma - were sisters that immigrated from Sweden in the early 1900's. Several of Vendla & Alma's brothers - Claus, Frans Oscar, Karl Julius & Victor (twin to Vendla) also immigrated. Their last name was either spelled Carlson or Karlson based on the transcriber when coming through Ellis Island. Leone was born on 11/11/1928 to her parents - Carl Arvid Johnson & Vendla Sofia Karlson - at Moose Lake, Minnesota, the final child to be added to the family. She married Daniel Kinseth on 03/16/1972 at Hennepin County, Minnesota.
