Lee spent his entire career at BHZ which spanned almost 58 years. He was BHZ's managing partner for 17 years. During Lee's time at BHZ, the firm grew from 15 employees to over 140. Lee had many great accomplishments throughout his life, both professionally and personally. He was a past chairman of the Management of Accounting Practice of CPA Firms, past board member of International Group of Accounting Firms, past member and arbitrator, American Arbitration Association, past and honorary member of American Institute of Certified

Public Accountants, past member, Minnesota Society of Certified Public Accountants. He was a past president of the Edina Chamber of Commerce, the Rotary Club of Edina, Minnesota Cystic Fibrosis Foundation and Kiwanis Club. Past board member and treasurer of Automotive Club of Minneapolis (AAA). Past board member of Interlachen Country Club and member of Collier's Reserve Country Club, Naples, FL. He was a past member of the President's Council at the University of St. Thomas and a longtime member and past finance committee member at the Church of St. Patrick in Edina. In 1984, Lee received the Edina Businessperson of the Year Award. In 1992, he received the Minnesota Society of CPA's Public Service Award and in 2000 he was honored with the Breath of Life Salute by the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation. Lee and Addie loved spending time with their children and grandchildren, traveling, golfing and wintering at their home in Florida, as well as spending time with their many friends. Over the last several years of Lee's life, he battled Parkinson's disease with courage and dignity, never complaining and always maintaining his incredible sense of humor.
