Nomm, Lisette M. Died on September 9th at the age of 99. Preceded in death by husbands Endel Nomm and Evald Rebane; sister Benata Kutt; brother in-law Elmar Kutt and grand nephew John E. Kutt. The oldest of four daughters, she was born to Juri and Natalie Kaljas on January 23, 1919 in Estonia. In the fall of 1944, fleeing the Soviet Occupation of her native Estonia with her husband Evald and daughter Maie, they sought refuge in Germany for several years living in Displaced Persons camps, established by the Allies after the war. In 1949, the family found sponsors in the United States and immigrated to Iowa. After a year and 1/2 the family moved to Minneapolis. She was a wonderful seamstress and dressmaker having graduated from Rakvere's vocational school for women at the top of her class. She committed her free time to supporting the Estonian community in Minneapolis. Lisette is survived by her daughter and son-in-law Maie and Ted Tammeauru; grandchildren Liina (Matthew) Richardson and Erik Tammeauru; great-grandchildren Erik, Annika, Avery Richardson, Lillian, Anna Tammeauru; nephew John (Ann) Kutt; Sisters Irlanda (Felix) Pajula and Lia (Raimond) Aasumets with niece in Estonia.
