There was a "war" among town kids (Pickle Parent had been my neighbor so I was on his side - Lloyd and Gayle were on the other side) and at one point Lloyd and Gayle captured Jimmy Hangsleben and me and put us in a pit in "Jungletown". They told us we had to stay there until they released us - I think they later came back and let us go but we were scared. Later he was a basketball and baseball star in high school and the little kids looked up to him. I recall one event when Lloyd and Leland Swanson executed a hidden ball trick on the baseball field that picked a guy off second base. I don't remember exactly how it worked but I thought it was one of the neatest things ever.
