Brandt, Lloyd L. age 92 of North Oaks, peacefully went to be with his Lord on Saturday, September 8, 2012. Preceded in death by his wife of 61 years, Lois; and brothers, Valmah and Robert. Survived by children, Lynn (Grover) Sayre and Mark (Denise) Brandt; grandchildren, Jordan (Jennifer), Dustin (Sheena), Taylor, Aaron, Lauren, and Jade; great-grandchildren, Tristan and Dafne; sisters, Alice Gould, and Helene (Grant) Zedicher; also survived by other family and friends. Lloyd graduated high school in 1938 and went on to Iowa State University in Ames, IA. Lloyd took a break during college to serve a tour in Guam as a Sgt. in the US Army. After his discharge, Lloyd returned to Iowa State to finish his degree. He had a love of flying, eventually earning his pilots license and purchased a couple of small planes to facilitate his managing farms for John S. Pillsbury. Lloyd came to Mpls in the 1950s to take a job with the Mpls. Chamber of Commerce. Lloyd played a pivotal role in convincing the US Government to create Voyagers National Park. While with the Chamber Lloyd spend many years as a lobbyist at the state capitol. Lloyd made his final career change in the mid 1970s taking on the role of Vice President of the Public Affairs Division of First Bank System. He retired as the President of The First Bank System Foundation in 1985. Lloyd kept busy after retirement running his own consulting business as well as serving on numerous boards including Citizens Scholarship Foundation, Lake States Interpretive Association, The Arboretum, The Minnesota Zoo, Northwestern College, Emmaus Bible College and chair of the Minnesota Children's Home Society.

Lloyd loved working with people and cherished the many friendships he developed over the years. In lieu of flowers, memorials preferred to Northwestern College or Emmaus Bible College.
