DeGenere, Lois of Crystal, Minnesota, died February 4, 2018, at the age of 94. She was born October 26, 1923, in Glenwood, MN, to Louie and Gertrude (Lohre) Christenson. Lois and Herb did not have children but they were both proud of their roles as aunt and uncle.
