



Lois Yvonne Hartmann

March 20, 1929 - April 21, 2016

Lois Yvonne Hartmann (nee Anderson), a gentle soul, died April 21, 2016, at Cherrywood Pointe in Roseville. She was 87. Lois was born to Gladys (Novak) and Theodore Anderson on March 20, 1929, and grew up in the Merriam Park neighborhood of St. Paul. She graduated from St. Paul's Central High School in 1946 and continued her education at Gustavus Adolphus College in St. Peter. Lois married John Hartmann of Minneapolis on December 17, 1949, and the couple lived in Norfolk, Virginia, and Winona, Minnesota, before settling in Minneapolis, where they had their four kids. They saw their youngest two children into adulthood in a home on Pike Lake in New Brighton, and Lois later lived in Mounds View. During John's years with degenerative Multiple Sclerosis, Lois cared for him while running the household and the family's business, Hartmann Office Products Inc., which was located in Roseville. She also cared for her aging father and mother-in-law, who joined her in the family's home in New Brighton. Lois enjoyed spending time with her children, grandchildren, and extended family. Along with her cousin and close friend Joanne Downey, she researched and documented her family's genealogy. She had sixty pen pals in the U.S. and abroad, and she maintained correspondence with them for many years. She also had a soft spot for cats, especially her favorite, Big Cat. She was preceded in death by an infant son, her husband, and her parents. She is survived by her brother, Ted (Evelyne) Anderson; by her children, Geoff Hartmann and Jamie Moore; Jeanne (Bill) Falconer; Alex Hartmann and
