Hopf, Lois Alberta McLean Age 101, of Edina passed away Sept. 18, 2018. Preceded in death by parents, Edward Mclean and Edna (Bacon) McLean; siblings Bethel, Beryl, Audrey and Dale; husband Walter Douglas Hopf; and daughter, Camille Donohue. Born in Austin, MN, 1917, Lois was a descendant of John Alexander Faribault. As a baby she moved with her family to Musselshell, MT where both parents died in the flu epidemic of 1919.
