



## Loleta Elizabeth Scott

Scott, Loleta Elizabeth Age 96, of Edina, MN., died September 24, 2020. Lo grew up in Mpls with her parents and sister and graduated from West High in 1941. She married John T (Tom) Scott, a lieutenant in the Navy in 1945. After WWII, Lo helped sew costumes in their newly purchased business, now known as Norcostco, Inc.
