DaMart, Lucille Mary Veronica of Edina, Minnesota. United States World War II Veteran. Born September 12, 1921. Passed away December 14, 2016. Graduate of St. Margaret Academy and was a graduate of St. Elizabeth's School for Nurses through Loyola University in 1942. Spent the next two years as a nurse at Bradford Memorial Hospital. Served in the Army as a Second Lieutenant Army Nurse Corps from 1944 - 1946. Served in France and Germany. Served the wounded from the Battle of the Bulge. After the war was over she was shipped to Heidelberg, Germany at the 101st Hospital where she had General Patton as a patient and became a WWII Veteran March 15, 1946 and was sent back to the States. She spent two years as a public health nurse in Philadelphia, PA, and then the next six years as an occupational staff nurse for George A. Hormel Company in Austin, MN. Then went on to work as an occupational health consultant for Liberty Mutual until her retirement. She has long been a resident of Edina at the Heritage of Edina. Preceded in death by sister Mary Jane Olson. Survived by brother Charles (Sue) from California; very special, caring and loving friend Bonnie Hagfors; and many nieces and nephews.
