Lynne Marie Gray, age 79, of Minnetonka MN left this world peacefully on July 22, 2024. She was born on VE Day, May 8, 1945.

Lynne was the oldest child of Roger James Gray and Agnes Rose Miller Gray who raised their six children in Robbinsdale, Minnesota. Lynne attended Sacred Heart grade school and St. Michael Catholic High School.

She had a long career in sales, most notably with Minnetonka Mills in Hopkins selling fabric and with Coldwell Banker Burnet as a real estate agent and home stager.

Lynne was a role model in her service to the community of St. Leonard's Catholic Church. She led the religious ed program and plant sale, directed the nativity play, and sewed banners and vestments.

She was an accomplished seamstress, cook, hostess, decorator and lover of beauty, art, fashion, culture and travel. Lynne was passionate about Lake Minnetonka history due to the family's heritage as territorial pioneers of Gray's Bay.

With a spirit of inclusion and generosity, Lynne took people under her wing and did many things to make people feel special. Lynne's dry sense of humor and gift of hyperbole were an innate part of who she was, and her many one-liners are woven into the fabric of family lore.
