Marcella Helen Schneider was born July 28, 1931 to Fred and Anna Schneider of Bristol, South Dakota. She graduated from Bristol High School and Northern State Teacher's College. She taught school for many years, starting in one room country schoolhouses on the prairies of South Dakota.

In July 1953 she married Herbert Hough of Bradley, South Dakota. Both Marcella and Herbert taught school in small South Dakota towns. They had one daughter, Lynette. Herbert died in 1968.

In December 1972 she married Harvey Teske and the tiny family of two became a family of five with Harvey's daughters Debby and Lorri. They lived near Aberdeen, South Dakota until 1979, when they moved to New Hope, Minnesota. Harvey passed away in 2013. Marcella moved to Maranatha Senior Living in Brooklyn Center, MN in 2018. Marcella passed away November 3, 2019.
