



## Margaret L. Holm

January 30, 1912 - December 7, 2015

Margaret Erickson Slaikeu Holm died peacefully on December 7, 2015 at the age of 103. She is survived by children Karl A. Slaikeu, Daniel N. Slaikeu, Stephen J. Slaikeu, and Alice Slaikeu Lawhead and by step-children Marion Holm Hoglund, Peter Holm, and Stephen Holm, by numerous grandchildren and great-grandchildren, and many loving friends. She was pre-deceased by Rev. Dr. Arthur Slaikeu (1967) and Rev. Reuben Holm (2000).
