December 8, 1921 - January 13, 2020

It's with sadness that we announce the passing of Margarett (Marg) on January 13, 2020. Marg passed away peacefully in her home at the age of 98 after a short battle with pulmonary fibrosis.

Marg was born in Chisholm, Minnesota on December 08, 1921. The family moved around due to her father's work as a carpenter and an electrician. They eventually settled in Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin, which she considered her home town. Growing up, Marg enjoyed roller skating at the rink in Bloomer. She shared stories of hitch-hiking to the rink with her friends. Marg graduated from nursing school as an RN. She met her husband, Richard, a resident, at Marquette University, where they married. They moved to Spokane, Washington, Dr. Jackson's home town, where they both practiced medicine and Michael, their eldest son, was born.

Marg lived in many places with her husband and family. In Riverside, California, Dr. Jackson served in the Air Force. In Rochester, Minnesota, both practiced medicine and son Patrick was born. They went back to California, then on to Memphis, Tennessee where Dr. Jackson taught at the university and Marg worked as an RN. After a second sojourn in Rochester, where both practiced medicine, they moved to Golden Valley when Dr. Jackson was invited to join an OB-GYN partnership. They finally settled in St. Louis Park. Marg worked both as the practice's RN and as the office manager for several years before retiring.

Marg's health had been in mild decline for the last several years, eventually

requiring 24x7 assistance. She grew to truly appreciate her caregivers, who enabled her to live a full life. In the weeks before her final illness, Marg enjoyed celebrating her 98th birthday with her family, and was delighted to be catered to (thanks Hy-Vee) in celebration of Christmas Day. Those celebrations may be our best memories.

Marg is survived by her elder son, Michael, and her friend Karen; her younger son, Patrick, and her grandchildren Harriet and Elliot.
