Krinke, Marian Augusta Marian was born on Feb 6, 1915 and went to be with the Lord on May 17, 2020. She was raised in Lamberton, MN and graduated from the University of MN with a B.S. in Home Economics. From 1944-1946 she volunteered as a recreational aid with the American Red Cross, attached to the 162nd General Hospital in Nocton, England. After the War she returned to the food service industry and home economics in the business field. She ended her career in 1981, retiring from International Multifoods, as Director of the Consumer Kitchens. In retirement she volunteered with the Presbyterian Church U.S.A. in Arizona, Utah and Alaska. She served as a Deacon and Elder at Hope Presbyterian Church, Richfield, MN where she had been a member since 1969. She was instrumental in the 1984 creation of the Clothing Center at Hope Church. Marian was predeceased by her parents, Augusta and Henry Krinke, sister Evelyn Pettersen, brother Harold Krinke and nieces Ruth Lanier and Kirsten Ihrke. She is survived by nieces Muriel Orr, Shoreview, MN; Janet Daniel, Horseshoe Bay, TX; Lorna McCullum, Thomasville, GA; Myra Hillburg, Long Beach, CA; nephews Ralph Pettersen, Rapid City, SD, Roger Krinke, New Brighton, MN; other relatives and many friends.
