



## Marion Jean Worsing

January 5, 1925 - October 15, 2025

Marion Jean Worsing (Anderson), age 100, of Bloomington, MN, passed away peacefully on October 15, 2025, at Edina MN in the arms of family.

Marion was born on January 5, 1925 in Clarks Grove, MN, to Aage and Margaret (Erickson) Anderson. She grew up on a farm in the Danish community of Clarks Grove. Marion was proud of her 100% Danish heritage and always considered herself a "farm girl". From the farm, Marion moved to Council Bluffs, IA where she graduated from Abraham Lincoln High School in 1942. During World War II, she worked as an electrician wiring electrical harnesses into combat planes. She took immense pride in her children, grandchildren and great grandchildren and was always their biggest supporter. Besides family, she lit up when in the company of "her" dogs.
