



Mr. Maris Bergmanis

November 7, 1935 - February 3, 2021

Bergmanis, Maris 85, of New Brighton, MN passed away peacefully surrounded by family on February 3, 2021, from complications relating to a fall. Maris was born in Jelgava, Latvia and immigrated to the United States in 1950. After graduating from High School in Lincoln, NE, he served 3 years in the Army's 543rd Field Artillery Missile Battalion. He then earned a Bachelor of Science in Electrical Engineering at the University of Nebraska in 1961. Maris worked as an electrical engineer at Control Data Corporation for 35 years and then Secure Computing Corp. (acquired by Intel), recently retiring at age 83. He was a member of the Latvian fraternity Talavija and was active in the Latvian Evangelical Lutheran Church in Minneapolis. Maris had a passion for history and astrophysics and enjoyed spending time with family, camping, skiing and enjoying the outdoors. He is survived by his loving family: his wife of 59 years, Astrida Bergmanis (Bendrups); two children Erik Bergmanis (Cindy) and Imanta Bergmanis (Paul Springob); six grandchildren Lindsey (Lance), Jenna (Pat), Robbie, Maddie, Jake, Jenna, Kyle and Laila; four great-grandchildren Logan, Landon, Lauren and Kinsley; as well as nephews Atti and Irabe. Maris is predeceased by his parents Kristops and Olga Bergmanis and his sister Maija Williams. His legacy will live on in the hearts and minds of his family, friends and others whom he touched. His final internment will be in his birthplace in Ile, Latvia. A celebration of his life will take place in the summer.
