“ Homily for those who follow in the footsteps of Mark Evans

*From the book of Wisdom, we heard:*

*The just man, though he die early, shall be at rest. For the age that is honorable comes not with the passing of time, nor can it be measured in terms of years. He who pleased God was loved ... he who lived among sinners was transported – snatched away.*

*Having become perfect in a short while, he reached the fullness of a long career; for his soul was pleasing to the Lord, therefore he sped him out of our midst.*

*From Paul’s letter to the Romans:*

*No one lives for oneself, and no one dies for oneself. For if we live, we live for the Lord. And if we die, we die for the Lord. So then whether we live or die, we are the Lord’s.*

*From Matthew’s gospel:*

*Come, you who are blessed by my Father. Inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. For I was hungry and you gave me food. I was thirsty, and you gave me drink. A stranger, and you welcomed me, naked and you clothed me, ill and you cared for me, in prison and you visited me.*

*The Life we celebrate in today’s scripture readings – and in the life of our friend, husband, child, father, brother, brother-in-law, fellow parishioner: Mark Evans – is really quite illuminating about something we usually think of as being somewhere over there. Beyond death’s door in the here-after. Something achieved solely after a virtuous life here-and-now.*

*That is, Heaven ... the Kingdom of God!*

*For centuries, Christians have used icons like this to help them*

*meditate on this most important reality, on heavenly reality. Icons are, in a very real sense, windows into heaven. And in gazing upon, in meditating on, for example, the Madonna and Child in this icon a Christian sees beyond the ephemeral, beyond the ever-changing, beyond surface-level reality all around us ... helping us see the really Real that surrounds all everyday life.*

*Gazing upon the unconditional love between the Mother of God and the Son of God, we have a glimpse of ... a peek into ... the divine love that God has for us. And through us.*

*Oh, if we only knew it! If we only accepted it! If we only lived it! If we only shared it!*

*Periodically, someone comes into our lives who does know it ... who does accept it ... who does live it ... who does share it. And in so doing, they serve as a flesh-and-blood icon of God's loving care for each and every one of us.*

*Today, we thank God for one such flesh-and-blood icon of God's love: our friend and genuine witness to the loving Way of Christ, Mark.*

*Two thousand years ago, Christ broke into history and brought the way of heaven with him. Ever since, we've been living in the world, but living sometimes of the world and sometimes of heaven.*

*Living icons like Mark help us see the really Real all around us. A reality here and now, and also in the here-after.*

*More importantly, flesh-and-blood icons like Mark help us to experience this heavenly reality ... they help inspire us to live in heaven and live out heaven right here, right now ... in anticipation of living in heaven for all eternity in the here-after.*

*I guess when someone as young and good as Mark dies, it is only understandable to wonder,*

*Why?*

*Why so young?*

*Why should God take such a good man?*

*Why should a young and good man go so prematurely to heaven?*

*I really can't answer the question as to God's timing. Perhaps we should be looking at the question from a different angle, though:*

*Given Mark's obvious and beautiful discipleship, his witness to the Kingdom, we could ask "Why were we blessed for so many incredible years as we have been?" "How did we rate so highly as to deserve 50 years of that flesh-and-blood icon of love, Mark?"*

*The answer is revealed in the flesh-and-blood icon here: Mark. We got Mark in our lives because we are so incredibly loved by God. And because God wanted us – and still wants us – to be inspired by Mark to see and live out the heaven that is all around us ... eventually infecting the rest of the world with heav*
