



Marvin John Ulrich

August 9, 1929 - November 5, 2020

Marvin Ulrich, 91, of Lakeville, formerly of Burnsville, went home to Heaven on November 5, 2020, after a two week battle with COVID-19. Marvin was born in New Ulm, to John and Emma (Tepe) Ulrich. He was baptized and confirmed at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in New Ulm. He attended high school at Dr. Martin Luther College in New Ulm, graduating in 1947. After graduation, he was employed as an apprentice electrician and later received his Journeyman Electrician's license in 1951. He then enlisted in the United States Air Force, where he first served for two years in Tokyo, Japan, in the US Intelligence Division during the Korean War. In October 1951, he married Janice Louise Diercks. Janice went home to Heaven in June 1954. From 1953 to 1955, Marvin was assigned to McChord Air Force Base in Tacoma, Washington, where he served in Administration until his four year enlistment was completed. At that time, he chose to return to civilian life, and was honorably discharged. He then returned to his family's electrical business in New Ulm. On June 30, 1957, Marvin was united in marriage to Victoria Helen Spaude. Their marriage was blessed with four children. They built their family home in Burnsville in 1966, where they lived until October 2019. Marvin worked as a service technician for General Electric for over 30 years, until his retirement. Marv enjoyed wood working, traveling, camping and hiking with his family (especially to the western US and Minnesota's North Shore) and all aspects of nature. He was bike riding 10 miles a day until age 87, logging his miles with the goal of biking the distance around the earth. Marvin is survived by his

loving wife of 62 years, Victoria; children, Tim (April) of Lakeville, Julie (Kurt) Loescher of Jackson, WI, Dave (Trish) of Washington, and Mary Ann (Helmut) Klingenschmitt of Rosemount; 18 grandchildren; 15 great-grandchildren; siblings, Lorna Starke of Michigan, and Jack of New Ulm, as well as a large extended family. He was preceded in death by his parents; siblings, Ruth, Erwin, Lorraine, Della, Hilda, Lillian; wife Janice; grandchildren Daniel Ulrich and Rachel Ulrich, and great grandchildren Elijah Loescher and Evelyn Loescher. The family plans a memorial service at Bloomington Living Hope Lutheran Church, followed by a military honors ceremony at Ft. Snelling National Cemetery in the spring of 2021.
