Arbisi, Mary Jane August 25, 1928 - September 3, 2021 Mary Jane Arbisi passed away the morning of September 3, 2021 at the age of 93. Daughter of Clarence and Gladys Cuff, Mary was born at the family farmhouse in the township of Hortonia, Wisconsin. After completing high school, Mary entered training to become a registered nurse at Presbyterian Hospital in Chicago. She then attended the School of Nursing at Marquette University in Milwaukee, specializing in Public Health. She later received a master's degree from The University of Minnesota. Mary was a veteran of the Naval Reserves, and spent her long career as a Public Health Nurse, caring for the wellbeing of underprivileged people in the Minneapolis area. She held progressive political beliefs, was an active member of AAUW, and was dedicated to community service. On September 20, 1969, Mary was wed to Anthony Laurence Arbisi in New London, Wisconsin. This was the first day of their remarkable 50 year union. Mary was a lifelong Congregationalist and an active member of Plymouth Congregational Church. She is preceded in death by her husband "Larry" Arbisi; brothers, James and George. Survived by her sisters, Joann and Dorothy; her step children, Mark, Joan, and Thomas, many nieces, nephews, and step grandchildren. Mary's Celebration of Life will be held at 10:00 AM, November 13, at Lakewood Cemetery Chapel, 3600 Hennepin Ave, Minneapolis, Minnesota, with the Reverend Beth Faeth officiating.
