Hughlett, Mary Anne (Sochko) of Maple Grove passed away Jan. 7 after 84 years filled with love and grace. Her family members are eternally grateful for the joy she brought to their lives. She was a kind, gentle and compassionate woman. Mary Anne grew up in north Minneapolis. She graduated from Patrick Henry High in 1957, the same year she met fellow Northsider Roger Hughlett. They married in 1961 and raised three children, primarily in Brooklyn Center. Family was always first: Mary Anne and Roger were inseparable, and she was devoted to her children. She was close to her grandchildren, always attending major events in their lives. Along with raising a family, she worked many jobs over the years, including tending the counter at Earle Brown Bowl and selling clothes and later furniture at Dayton's and its successors. Her department store job was fitting: she had style and loved to shop, particularly with her daughter and her Macy's employee discount card! Mary Anne' aesthetic flair was manifest in her many flower gardens. She took a lot of pride in design and plant selection; Gerbera daisies were a favorite. Mary Anne's health had declined in recent years, but she didn't lose hope. She is survived by her husband, Roger; sons Michael Hughlett and Steven (Darla) Hughlett; daughter Jennifer (Craig) Hollander; brother John (Phyllis) Sochko; grandchildren, Alexandra Murray, Evan, Cyrus and Jackson Hughlett, and Zoe
