



## Mary Lou Augusta (Kruger Wood) Moe

Moe, Mary Lou Augusta (Kruger Wood) was born into life on February 9, 1927 and entered into Eternal Life on Monday, January 27, 2014 at age 86. Mary Lou grew up on a farm in Potsdam, Minnesota, and attended Rochester Senior High School graduating in 1944 and graduated Summa Cum Laude as a Medical Secretary from Rochester Junior College. One month prior to the end of WWII, she married Robert E. Wood (1945). Her work as a medical secretary allowed Robert (Bob) to attend art school & together they had 4 children. Mary Lou's second marriage was to John H. Moe, MD. Dr. Moe (deceased) was widely regarded as the Founder of Modern Scoliosis Research and Treatment. He helped create one of the first dedicated inpatient hospital spine units in the world. Mary Lou worked beside Dr. Moe at Twin City Scoliosis Center (now Twin City Spine Center). Together, they traveled throughout the world, experiencing a life most others only dream about. In later years and prior to her retirement in Bloomington, MN, Mary Lou worked as a bookkeeper for her son & grandson.
