Mary Margaret Wierman (née Beckman), 85, was called from this world to her Lord and Savior Almighty on Saturday, September 27th, 2025. Born on a Sunday to Myrtle and Joseph Beckman, on April 28th, 1940 in Cincinnati, Ohio. Peggy, as she was called by her immediate family, graduated from high school in 1957. She married her one true love, Roger Wierman, at the Basilica of St. Mary in 1962.
