Mary Lee later returned to work as an elementary school nurse and as the nurse at the 4-H building during the MN State Fair for many years until her retirement.

could be found tending to her plants or sitting at the sewing machine. She was an avid gardener, transforming her yard into a sanctuary for birds, bees, vegetables and flowers. As an exceptionally talented sewer, she poured love into every stitch of the clothing that she crafted for family and friends.

Mary Lee was preceded in death by her parents and two of her siblings. She is survived by her husband, children, grandchildren and 7 siblings.
