Mary Theresa Reinart (Nee Kick) passed away peacefully on Sunday, November 26, 2023 at the age of 87.

She was born on May 1, 1936 in Lead, SD to a hard working immigrant family from Bavaria, Germany (father) and South Tyrol, Austria (mother).
