Beth played a major role in the foundations challenge grant to Allina Hospice to fund the construction of the J.A. Wedum Residential Hospice Facility in Brooklyn Park. Her personal end of life journey with John not only led to the vision of such a facility, but became in her lifetime a reality. How proud she was to see her dream fulfilled and the doors open just weeks ago. Beth loved to travel and she and John used every opportunity to explore the world and experience different cultures. They lived many places during their lives, each and every one of them leading to new friendships and adventures. They shared a love most would envy and were soul-mates to the end. Beth is
