*My thoughts and heart are with you during this time of loss and reflection. My remembrances of Mike date back to the Edman family's days in Fergus Falls, Minnesota – a mere 60 years ago! Mike and I were Adams Elementary School classmates, playing basketball together and listening to music. In early 1964, an up-and-coming band debuted on the Ed Sullivan show – and the Beatles were about to become rock-and-roll legends. Mike loved their music, and at some point, during this period of Beatles-mania, I recall Mike somehow finding/ordering what I can best describe as “Beatle wigs” (see: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=jenWdylTtzs>). I believe Mike also had a guitar – and he wanted us to wear the wigs, pretend we were a rock band, and pantomime as we listened to Beatles' music. I'm guessing we were a disappointment to Mike – but had fun nonetheless!
