Michael David Warman of Eden Prairie, MN, was born on Aug. 30th, in St. Cloud, MN to Juliet and Byron Warman.

He grew up in Sauk Centre, MN and was the youngest of 11 kids. Michael did his undergraduate work at North Dakota and St. Cloud Universities and then graduated from St. Cloud University with a Master's Degree in Biology, Anatomy, and a Teaching Certificate. He served in the U.S. Navy for 4 years as a Hospital Corpsman, stationed in Great Lake, IL, teaching Anatomy and lived in a cave on an island off the coast of Taiwan, looking after the service men there. He also taught the island children English in their school. He played piano professionally for most of his adult life along with a variety of other jobs including Warehouse Manager.

Michael was married to Dennis Senn on Aug. 4th, 2013 but were together for almost 43 years. He and Dennis adopted two sons, Adam and Michael (Mikey) Warmansenn.

Michael died peacefully in his sleep on Monday, February 10th, 2025 at 4:30 pm at the VA Medical Center. His death was due to complications with Mesothelioma Lung Cancer from his exposure to asbestos while serving in the Navy.

He was survived by his spouse, Dennis Senn, two sons, Adam and Mikey Warmansenn, sister Jean Andrews, brother and sister in-laws, many nieces and nephews, and cousins on both sides. Family and many close friends standing in the 'white light' to greet Michael into Heaven are: his parents,
