Mildred Loraine Prill passed away just before sunrise on June 7, 2024, at Founder's Ridge Presbyterian Homes in Bloomington, Minnesota. Millie, as her friends called her, was born on November 23, 1928, to parents Herman and Lydia Zellmer in Amboy, Minnesota. She married Ervin Walter Prill in 1949, and the young couple left their family farms to make a new life for themselves in the Twin Cities. They lived in Richfield for a short time, then purchased a lot from a farmer in the far-flung village of Bloomington to build a house for their future family. Millie would call Bloomington home for the next 70 years.

Millie enjoyed gardening, knitting, and was a devoted Minnesota Twins fan. She was an active member of Berea Lutheran Church. After retiring from B. She enjoyed playing bingo, attending worship services and music performances, and making new friends. She is survived by her sons Dan (Katherine) and David (Lily), many nephews, nieces, and
