



Rev. Mons Arthur Teig

March 23, 1935 - May 11, 2019

Teig, Mons Arthur Age 84, of Wayzata died at home on 5/11/19. Mons was born 3/23/35 in Cedar Rapids, Iowa to Mons Sr and Olive (Hovick) Teig. He attended Waldorf and Concordia colleges; held Masters' degrees from Luther Seminary, Union Seminary, Notre Dame; and a PhD from Graduate Theological Union in Berkeley, CA. He was an Assoc Pastor at Trinity Lutheran in Brooklyn, NY, a Sr Pastor at Palisades Lutheran in Pacific Palisades, CA, and a Professor of Worship at Luther Seminary in St Paul, MN. He treasured his students and helped shape the church of today. Through his work at the American Lutheran Church, he became known globally as a worship and liturgy expert. Mons is survived by his beloved wife of 61 years Shirley, children Laurie (Todd) Zaugg, and Stephanie Teig (Brad Nylin), grandchildren Taylor (Hannah), Emmy (Cam), Sam, Katerina, Chase and Kenzie. Brothers Dave (Dixie) and Loren (Debbie), Brother-in-law Tom Schlueter, and Sister-in-law Dorothy Lundy, many special nieces, nephews and Godchildren. He is preceded in death by his parents and sister Karen Schlueter. A Funeral Eucharist will be held at Central Lutheran Church (333 S 12th St, Minneapolis) May 25th.
