Myrna was born on September 9, 1933 in Aneta, North Dakota to Mabel Flohaug Michael and Wilbur Michael. She attended high school in Aneta, North Dakota and then went to teachers' training school. She taught for a brief time in a one-room schoolhouse before marrying Glenn Lowell Brudvig when he returned to the US after serving as medic in the Korean War.

Myrna was a homemaker raising their family in Grand Forks, ND, while Glenn went to college and worked at the University of North Dakota, and later in New Brighton, MN and Sierra Madre, CA while Glenn worked at the University of Minnesota and The California Institute of Technology (Caltech).

Myrna always loved the Midwest and the simplicity of the Great Plains and farmlands of Minnesota. She took great pride in her children and home. She

loved to travel - going to many far-flung parts of the world to visit her family. She especially loved Africa and adored the wide-open spaces and animals on safari.

Glenn and Myrna retired back to Minnesota where she remained for the rest of her life and continued to travel the world in her later years.

Myrna was preceded in death by her husband of 53 years and their daughter Muriel.

She is survived by her sons Gary (Colleen), Lee (Helen), James (Susan), by her daughter Kristin (Aurél), and also by her ten grandchildren (Lars, Erik, Karin, Ingrid, Karl, Kevin, Steven, Odin, Mathilda and Sven) and seven great-grandchildren (Linnea, Leif, Axel, Nova, Élise, Gustav and Henri).
