



Naghi Beyzavi

August 9, 1943 - November 6, 2023

Naghi Beyzavi, of Borujerd, Iran passed away Monday, November 6, 2023 in Golden Valley, Minnesota. He was 80.

The cause was attributed to complications of Kidney failure.

Naghi is a well known architect in Iran with experience expanding 50+ years. He was a high calibre student at Melli University (currently known as Beheshti University) who before graduating, began his career working for numerous prominent architecture firms in Tehran, Iran. As head architect for Tehran University expansion projects, he was chosen to lead the design of Razi University which marks the start of his firm; 'Raziran consulting Architects' with 6 other partners in 1983. The firm was very successful in many disciplines including Higher Education, Governmental, Religious, Commercial, Residential, and many more. Naghi received International invitations to participate in projects in UAE, Uganda and Azerbaijan, and received numerous awards for his design accomplishments.

Naghi Beyzavi was born August 9, 1943 in Iran to Taghi Beyzavi, and Showkat Favakehi. He had an interest in languages, ranging from Germanic, Middle Eastern, to Esperanto, with an in-depth focus in Italian, which naturally lead to films, and traditional and popular music coming from Italy, Iran, and the likes of the rat pack in the states, in addition to having original Tom Jones, Andy Williams, Beatles' and many more vinyls. His instrument of choice was

the accordion.

Naghi will be remembered for his humble presence, and his chivalrous attitude. His wealth of knowledge made him an encyclopedic source, and his sense of humor and quick wit expressed his charm. He was devoted to provide selflessly for his loved ones, and took on the role of leadership from a young age. Some of his personality traits were being an avid newspaper reader, having a pen or pencil on hand for a quick sketch, and best of all, creating memories/experiences, capturing such moments with an old school camera, and detailing the events with notes behind each developed photo. Although he will be dearly missed, his influence is heartfelt.

Naghi is set to rest at 2 pm on Wednesday, November 8, 2023, at Washburn-McReavy Dawn Valley, 9940 Bush Lake Rd, Bloomington, Mn in vicinity to his parents Taghi Beyzavi, and Showkat Favakehi, and his beloved cousin and friend, Alireza 'Pesaramoo' Beyzavi.
