We are sad to announce the passing of Nancy Elaine Reichow on Sunday, May 28, 2023.

Born in Toledo, Ohio on February 13, 1944, she grew up in Omaha, Nebraska, but spent most of her life in suburban Minneapolis/St. Paul. She graduated from Metro State University, enjoyed a successful career as a Human Resources Manager and retired in 2002.
