Nancy (Sparks) Seeley, went peacefully home to heaven on May 10, 2024, at the age of 89. Nancy worked at Benson Optical where she was a receptionist and stylist for 15+ years. After retiring from Benson's she went to work for the Embassy Suites serving breakfast and doing numerous sewing repairs. When she wasn't working Nancy loved watching soap operas, she enjoyed playing cards, went to "Club", and spent time with her children and grandchildren. Nancy thoroughly enjoyed many family trips to New England and Florida. Whether in the pool, on her driveway or on a beach she loved basking in the sun. Nancy's favorite time of the year was Christmas. She always had a real tree that needed to be tied to the ceiling so it wouldn't fall over. Oftentimes the tree was so large it left very little room to move about the living room. Nancy's favorite tree was the white Santa Tree with all her pink Santa ornaments. After many years the tree changed into a pastel Santa tree (there are only so many pink Santas available).
