Nathan Richard Keller, 26 of Edina unexpectedly passed away into the loving arms of his Heavenly Father on Oct. 31, 2023. He was stricken with a rare pulmonary embolism. Upon birth, his parents selected his name because he truly was "a gift given by God". As a child Nathan was always inquisitive, occasionally leading to a bit of mischief, which he regarded as fun. However, he always had a gentle caring spirit and an enormous sensitive heart. Nathan attended Our Lady of Grace School in Edina K-8th grade where developed his strong foundation in faith.
