Stake Nels Stanley "Stan" Stake, age 87, a resident of Hillcrest of Wayzata. Born March 27, 1917; died January 9, 2005. Preceded in death by his younger brother, Richard. Survived by loving wife of 56 years, Betty; 3 sons & daughters-in-law, Bill & Lyn of Basking Ridge, NJ, Eric & Michele of Merion, PA and Jim & Mimi of Edina; 7 grandchildren. Stan served as a Pilot in the Air Transport Command in the Pacific Theater during WW II where he flew many missions over "the hump" between India and China. He was a member of the Lutheran Church of the Good Shepherd, where he was a frequent vocal soloist and church council leader. He also served as a Regent of Augsburg College. A longtime Honeywell employee, Stan's career took him from his hometown of Chicago to Pittsburgh, Philadelphia, and finally to Minneapolis, retiring there as Senior Vice President of the Commercial Buildings Group.
