Nichole was such a kind, loving, caring big hearted person, she put her ALL into everything she

did and into people around her that she cared about, she was always so complimentary to people and did and said such thoughtful things.

Always present on social media but rarely was involved in social functions, her intentions were always there but generally cancelled because of her severe migraines and sleepless nights.

Nichole loved taking pictures has made many shutter fly books and very into jewelry making, scrapbooking and shopping on eBay, just shopping in general, her closet is all color coordinated, actually her entire Apt was and still is spotless, she was very OCD about organization even her car was kept pristine. She was an awesome artist mainly drawing and designing nail art and could do awesome face painting on kids.

She was a master at imitating people and subtle ways people may pronounce a word and tease you about it, Excellent memory, so into SMELLS she smelled everything and even herself always smelled good, god help you if you stood too close to her after a cigarette or a coffee drinkers breath. She had a few habits one being "MONKEY FACE" and constantly using chapstick. Her handwriting was so beautiful. If she was given \$100.00 she could make it last for a month, she was so thrifty and coupons were a big part of her life.

I am sure so much more will come to me that I wish I had shared but I think

you all know her and her little quirks. I guess more than anything, her life was her cat Bellie! Thank god for Bellie she licked away every tear on Nichole and Bellie is in pain now with the loss of her Mommy but I will be giving her all my love. Nichole left a very long journal entry on her last day and was very specific about her wishes and feelings and we are trying now to all do good by her.

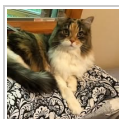

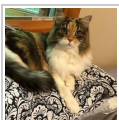
