Nickolas "Nick" John Sulack. 42 years old. Passed away unexpectedly Thursday April 17th, 2025 at his home in Bloomington, MN with his wife Lisa and daughter Evelyn. Nick's cause of death is unknown at this time.

He is preceded in death by his mother Pam Sulack, whom he loved and admired greatly and carried on many of her traditions in her honor.

He is survived by his loving wife of 16 years Lisa Sulack, daughter Evelyn Sulack, father John Sulack, siblings Karin (Andrew Butz) Sulack and Carla (Bret) Brown, nephew Hunter Willett, nieces Celia Willett, Zoey Willett, Sylvia Sulack and Audrey Sulack.

Nick worked throughout high school, college (NDSU for undergrad and Bethel for his Master's) and adulthood in varying careers providing a range of person-centered services to support individuals with disabilities and vulnerable adults as a Program Manager, Counselor, Program Director and Training Specialist. It wasn't until 2025 that Nick found his true calling as a Teacher, Nick had been teaching at the Minneapolis Hennepin Schools grades K-8 and also the Bloomington School District as a Substitute Teacher for the various middle schools and high school. Nick had plans to go back to get his Teaching License because he found such profound and complete joy working with children. Every day he would come home and excitedly tell his wife all about

his day at school and share the pictures he drew on the whiteboard for the children under "Mr. Sulack", and share the varying stories and successes of his day. After many years of finding happiness caring for the most vulnerable populations, he had found his place and a greater passion, helping shape and guide young minds.

In Nick's free time he loved to frisbee golf with his friends, wife and daughter, he loved collecting discs and teaching others about his love of the sport. Nick loved to play the family card game "13", cribbage with his father-in-law, Clue with his wife and daughter, puzzles and bananagrams with his wife. All of which were incredibly competitive and held a degree of smack talk to make it more fun. He loved our time at the family cabin in Crosslake fishing and driving the pontoon, patiently teaching all the little ones how to drive, and depending on your age whipping you around behind the pontoon or speedboat on a tube. He enjoyed doing whatever DIY project his wife thought of next as they fixed up their townhouse, it was more the company than the project. He was an avid chef in the kitchen and on his grill, he expressed his love through his food and a great joy of his was giving a full and satisfied belly to his friends and family. There are so many things Nick did in his life and at the center of it was his love for others, he was self-less and always happy to help, everything he did was to make others happy. You could see this in the casual sleepy mornings he helped Evelyn make her school lunch, the way he threw the frisbee every day for their doodle Ellie, and the gentle way every single night he tucked his wife in for bed and kissed her goodnight.

He will be deeply and profoundly missed to our cores, everything he did, he did with love, compassion, kindness, humility and grace. The loss we feel is immeasurable, but what is eternal is his life now in heaven with God our Savior and Creator as he was a true believer in our Lord Jesus Christ.
