Myers Nolan Philip Myers, age 18, of Carver, MN, struck and killed by a drunk driver November 1st in Raleigh, NC while saving the life of another college student. A 2003 graduate of Eden Prairie High School. He was a freshman at Campbell Christian University in Buies Creek, NC. Nolan was best known for his sense of humor, his mission and ministry work at Grace Church, his masterful drumming, and as an aircraft pilot.
