Norman Pink, 90 of Minnetonka died peacefully on March 9. Norman was born on April 20, 1934. He attended Southwest High School in Minneapolis and graduated from the University of Minnesota. He was a successful businessman who dedicated himself to both his business and to his community, focusing first and foremost on the relationships he built. Norman served as president of D.A.R.E, president of his trade association, Amusement & Music Operators Association, twice president of Adath Jeshurun Congregation, as well as serving on various community boards including the Jewish Community Center and the Jewish Historical Society of the Upper Midwest. His greatest devotion, however, was to his wife of 63 years, his children and grandchildren. He is predeceased by his parents, Dr. David and Dena Pink, daughter Janet Specht and son-in-law David Specht, and granddaughter Liel Pink.
