often settled into her favorite chair by the fireplace, watching westerns on AMC.

She also had a deep love for her dogs, caring for them as if they were part of the family in every way.

Pam was sweet, kind, unique, and deeply caring. But above all else, she loved her children. Her love was the foundation of her family, and it will live on in each of them.

After courageously fighting for six days in the ICU and spending her final days in comfort care, Pam passed peacefully with her children by her side. In those last days, her family came together-sharing stories, laughter, and tears, holding her hand and surrounding her with love until the very end.

She is now reunited with her beloved former husband, Scott Kjorness, whom we lost two years ago. While our hearts are broken, we find comfort in knowing they are together again.

Pamela is survived by her sons, Justin Kjorness (Nicole), Jesse Dinwiddie (Kelly Van Ravenhorst), Leif Kjorness, and Zach Kjorness (Laura Salazar); her daughters, Cieara Vidor (Joshua) and Sydney Kjorness; and her grandchildren, Christian Herring, Leilly Kjorness, Louis Kjorness, Mackenzie Dinwiddie, Marleigh Horn, Reagan Vidor, and Cole Vidor.
