Sorensen, Patricia Jean (Robertson) entered into the care of her beloved Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, on Dec. 9 at the age of 88 years and 348 days. Patricia was born at Eitel Hospital on Dec. 26, 1920. Her parents were Frederick Robertson and Genevieve Houghton Robertson who lived in the Lake of the Isles area of Minneapolis. She is survived by her brother, Frederick of Oceanside, CA. Patricia attended Jefferson Jr. and West High School, graduating in 1939. She studied at Walker Art Center and the Minnetonka Art Center. Patricia met her future husband, Neal E. Sorensen on Sept. 6, 1946. They were engaged to be married 13 days later and set the wedding date for June 17, 1947. They were married by Rev. Dr. Morris Robinson at Grace Presbyterian Church on Humboldt and 28th St. South in Minneapolis. Patricia had three children, Neal Jr., Dane Charles and Diane Jean Umeda. She has four grandchildren, Gary Umeda of Hawaii, Alexa Connelly, Adria and Anesa Sorensen of Ely, Minnesota. Patricia was an excellent potter and produced award winning pottery while working at Minnetonka Art Center. Patricia co-founded the first Minnesota Bottle Club with interest in 18th century art glass and historic flasks which marked the notable events of that century.
