“ I remember how proud Pat was of his Herbster home when he finally finished it up. He gave my daughter and I a tour and a tour of the area in his side by side.

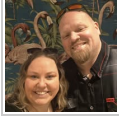
His smile would light me up and made such a difference to my days when we would cross paths at our workplace.
