



## Patrick Bowen Nicholas Solomon

May 18, 1981 - April 13, 2025

Patrick Bowen Nicholas Solomon was born May 18, 1981, in Provo, Utah, to Mary Karen Bowen Solomon and Mark Jeffrey Solomon. His grandparents were Donna Jenkins Bowen and Norman Bowen, and Phyllis Morse Solomon and Louis Maurice Solomon. When he was two, Patrick's family moved to North Charleston, South Carolina, because his father had joined the US Navy.

At the end of his 2nd grade school year, his parents separated, and his mother moved them to Springville, Utah to be closer to family. They lived there for two years, then moved to Craig, CO. Patrick finished his high school education in Craig. He was a member of the track team, played trumpet in the band, and developed his own musical group with a few friends.

After graduating in 1999, Patrick chose to serve a mission in Norway for the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter day Saints. After returning home in 2004, Patrick went to Brigham Young University to study journalism. While attending BYU, he met Amanda Bingham. Patrick and Amanda were married on April 22, 2005, in the Salt Lake Temple.

Patrick graduated with a degree in communications in May, 2008. He began law school at BYU in the Fall of 2009, and completed an internship in Trondheim, Norway that summer. He did well in law school, worked on the law review, and celebrated the birth of their daughter, Piper in 2011. After he

graduated in the top 5% of his law school class, and passed the bar exam on his first try, he accepted a clerkship at the Court of Appeals in Phoenix, Arizona.

Patrick and Amanda welcomed a son, Crispin, in 2014. Patrick worked in Arizona for a few more years, then moved to Minneapolis with his family in 2019. Patrick most recently worked for Clio, a legal technology company headquartered in British Columbia. He enjoyed both the creativity and scope of the work at Clio as well as the people that he worked with. His death on Palm Sunday, April 13, 2025, a month and five days before his 44th birthday, was too soon for his family and all those who knew him and loved him.

Patrick was preceded in death by his grandparents and his father, Mark Jeffrey Solomon. Patrick is survived by his wife, Amanda, daughter Piper, son Crispin, his mother and stepfather Mary Karen Solomon and Joseph Huelskamp, and his sisters Anna Dey (Will) and Sophie Bigelow (Ben).
